After working as an electronic research engineer in Civil Service, recruited by LEO as trainee maintenance engineer. Took responsibility for training customer engineers and rose to oversee all LEO training as well as managing engineering maintenance services, and was also personnel officer. He was always helpful and friendly and well-liked by colleagues. He briefly left LEO to join a management consultancy but returned to become head of customer support services for EELM. Completed his career with ICL as manager, Large Projects before setting up his own consultancy. He retired in 1988 and published a book on Project Management. Gained reputation as a safe pair of hands for complex and difficult assignments. One of the stalwarts whose contribution played a key role in the success of LEO.
